

# FIX

## Syntax

```
N  = FIX( X )
```

## Parameter

X is a number

## Description

The truncated integer, part of X. FIX (X) is equivalent to  $\text{SGN}(X) * \text{INT}(\text{ABS}(X))$ . The major difference between FIX and INT is that FIX does not return the next lower number for negative X.
